## Holy Spirit Directed Vision Produces Passion For Our Mission

**I am writing this article for one purpose, to convince you to come to The Congregation Meeting & Vision Night with a huge potluck on Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 5:00 – 7:00 pm.**

I am asking this favor of you, please come. It is important to the future mission of St. Luke and to the leaders of our congregation to have you there. I am confident that you will have an enjoyable evening and you never want to miss a good old-fashion Lutheran potluck. I have the fondest memories of church potlucks growing up. It seemed like potluck was a third sacrament in the church where I was raised. What is most important on November 13<sup>th</sup> is that we renew our vision for our mission.

**Let me share with you how God’s vision has been recently renewed in me.** One of the things that I try to do in these monthly articles is to tell you a little about myself. I have been told I need to do this more often. While I normally tell you something from my earlier life, let me tell you about where my thinking was this past summer. I hope you will hear what I am about to tell you with a calm heart. During this past summer I was experiencing what is described in the King James Version of Proverbs 29:18, “*Where there is no vision, the people perish.*” I felt stuck. I had very little excitement for our mission at St. Luke. I was beginning to wonder whether my time at St. Luke was coming to a close. I even called the Bishop’s office to have a chat about my future.

**Right about that time, God, the Holy Spirit, breathed a fresh wind into me.** A relatively small decision triggered this. It was the decision to propose this change to our Sunday morning schedule, starting January 8, 2012: 8:15 – Traditional Worship; 9:30 – Life Group Hour (Sunday School); 10:30 – Contemporary Worship; 11:30 – Traditional Worship. You have heard about this change and hopefully shared your thoughts about it. After listening to many of you, the Congregational Council Elders approved this change at the October 10<sup>th</sup> council meeting. We have been dancing about this issue for years. We believe that a dedicated Christian Education hour will help more people to **both learn of God’s love in worship and live out God’s love in a Life Group** (Sunday School class, Small Group, Bible Study, Prayer Group). When we finally made the decision to propose this change, it was like a fresh wind of the Spirit blew into me and I regained my passion for our mission.

**Our mission is to be and make disciples of Jesus Christ.** When we have a simple and clear vision of how we will accomplish this mission, then the prophecy of Joel that is quoted of this article is fulfilled and passion for our mission is produced. ***Our vision is to be a sanctuary where God’s love is learned, lived, and unleashed.*** We are to be about the work of God changing lives and eternal destinies through His love in Christ Jesus. When a person becomes a disciple of Jesus, he or she often joins a church. It is the responsibility of that church to do whatever it can to help that new or renewed Christ Follower grow into a spiritually mature and fully-devoted follower of Jesus Christ. That is making disciples! In the last 11 years, **1001 people have joined St. Luke.** That is a lot of people that have come to ***learn of God’s love*** in worship at St. Luke. While that is something about which to give God all the glory, we know that far too many of these people have since dropped away from active participation in a church or have not taken next steps to grow into spiritual maturity. God is calling us to do better at helping people to take the next steps to ***live God’s love*** in a life group of friends and to ***unleash God’s love*** through evangelism and serving others to meet their hopes and hurts.

**I am fired up about the vision God has revealed to us!** I am excited to see the new spiritual growth that God will bring as we implement the change in January. We believe this change will move more people into both worship and a life group on Sunday morning. Would you give the leadership of St. Luke the gift of a couple hours of your time on Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, so that we can share with you the compelling vision of how God is leading us to be and make disciples? Please see the information on pages 3 and 8 of this newsletter that further describes our Vision Night and Potluck.

- 1 package cookies

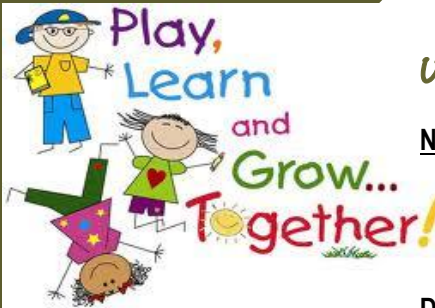

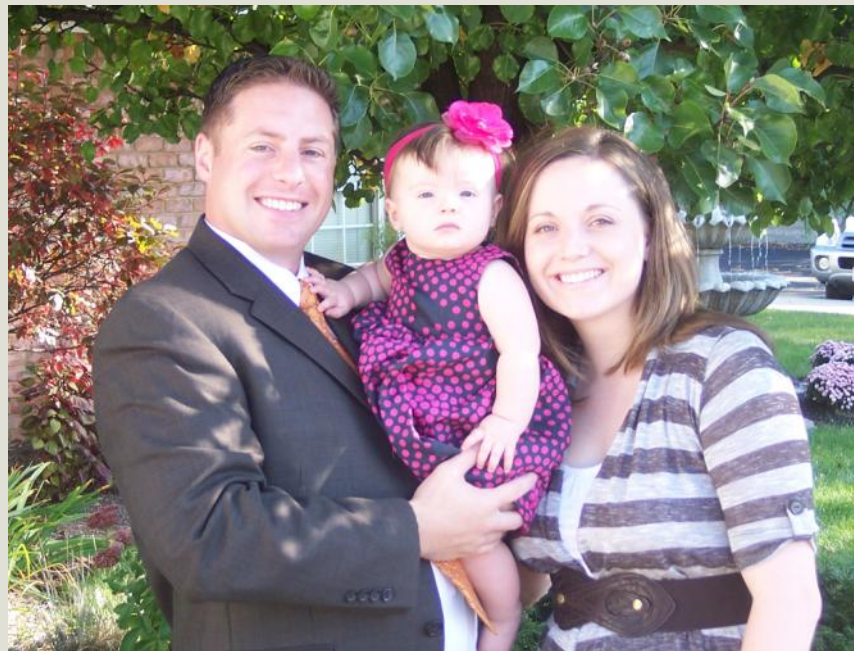

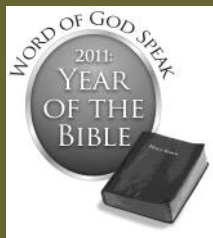
