**PURPOSEFUL CHANGE TO OUR SUNDAY MORNING SCHEDULE**

*Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:2*

**On a comfortable-with-change scale I would be closer to the comfortable end.** My parents told me that one of my first words was "I bore," which they knew meant that I was bored and wanted some new excitement. They figured they were in for a wild ride with me from early on. I am okay with change most of the time. There have been times, however, when I did not react well to change. From 5<sup>th</sup> grade through 9<sup>th</sup> grade, I played quarterback on the football team. I was not very talented, so most of the time I was the back-up signal caller. I loved playing football and was comfortable playing backup to one of the stars of a very talented team. Then one day at the beginning of 10<sup>th</sup> grade, right before the season was to start, I looked at the depth chart and found that my name had been moved to the offensive guard position. I played out the year at guard and even started JV, which would not have happened for me at quarterback. The coaches were encouraging about my play at guard, but I did not like the change. That was my last year playing organized football, a game I so enjoyed.

**Some say change in life is inevitable.** Spiritually, change is God's preferred mode for us. It is the work of God, the Holy Spirit, to continually transform us to be more fully-devoted followers of Christ; to move us from "here" (where we are now) to "there" (where God is changing us to be more like Jesus). This could be called the discipleship path. The problem is that we often like being "here" even if being "here" has become spiritually stagnant and we have stopped growing along the path of discipleship. "Here" is often our comfort zone.

**St. Luke's Leadership** (staff, elders, and ministry team leaders) have concluded that we need to make some changes to better fulfill Christ's great commission to "Go and make disciples." Therefore, we are proposing some changes in the way we do ministry. We are reorganizing our ministry structure to more intentionally and clearly encourage people to move along this discipleship path: **LEARN God's love in Worship à LIVE God's love in Life Groups à UNLEASH God's love through serving others**. Life Groups include Sunday school classes for all ages, small groups, Bible studies, and prayer groups. In Life Groups we gather with a small circle of Christian friends to live out together what God's Word is teaching us.

**One of the barriers to this discipleship path that we have at St. Luke is our Sunday morning schedule.** As you can see below, those adults and children who prefer to worship at the contemporary worship are not able to attend both worship and Sunday school. Also, children in grade 8 and younger attend Sunday school at a different time from those in high school. This is disruptive to families. Our adult Sunday school offerings are minimal. For these reasons, we need an improved and dedicated Life Group (Sunday school) hour. We are proposing this change to our Sunday morning schedule to begin Sunday, January 8, 2012.

These proposed changes were introduced on Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup> and you will be hearing much more about this St. Luke Discipleship Path in the months to come. Please let any of the staff or elders know your thoughts about these proposed changes. The council will be making the final decision on this at its October 10<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**A personal note:** When I was a senior, the classmates that I had played football with won our football-crazy town's only state championship. I was not on the team because I didn't like the change in my position. I missed out on a transforming experience that I will always regret.
