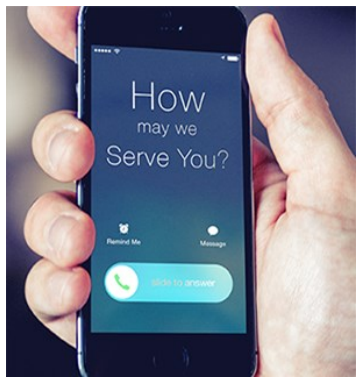
WORSHIP & MUSIC
