- Martin Luther explained the 3rd Commandment, "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy." *We are to fear and love God so that **we do not neglect his Word and the preaching of it, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it.*** Small Catechism
- *If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and **believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.** For it is with your heart that **you believe and are justified**, and it is with your mouth that **you profess your faith and are saved.*** Romans 10:9-10
- How does one come to have a saving faith? **Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.** Romans 10:17
