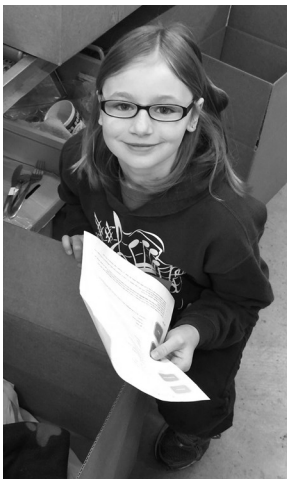

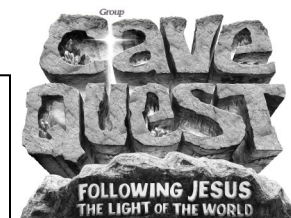
CHILDREN & STUDENTS
