Security and Keyed Entry Changes at St. Luke. Throughout August and September, we will be installing magnetic locks on the Fellowship Hall entry doors to provide for automatic locking/unlocking on a preset schedule. The church office door will also be placed on a magnetic lock with a visual and audio intercom system. New security fobs, similar to keyless entry fobs for vehicles, will be required to access the church office door and the Fellowship Hall doors during off hours, and all other exterior doors will be re-keyed with blank locks. We will be issuing the fobs on a need-to-have basis, and will update you as the process proceeds.


