5. 1 Corinthians 12:7-10 In these verses, what do we learn about God bringing us strength beyond what we thought possible?
 - ***In order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me.*** V. 7

- **Three times** I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. V. 8

- ***But the Lord said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, **for my power is made perfect in weakness.**”*** V. 9a

- *Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.* Vss. 9b - 10
