

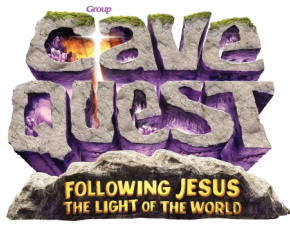
CHILDREN & STUDENTS

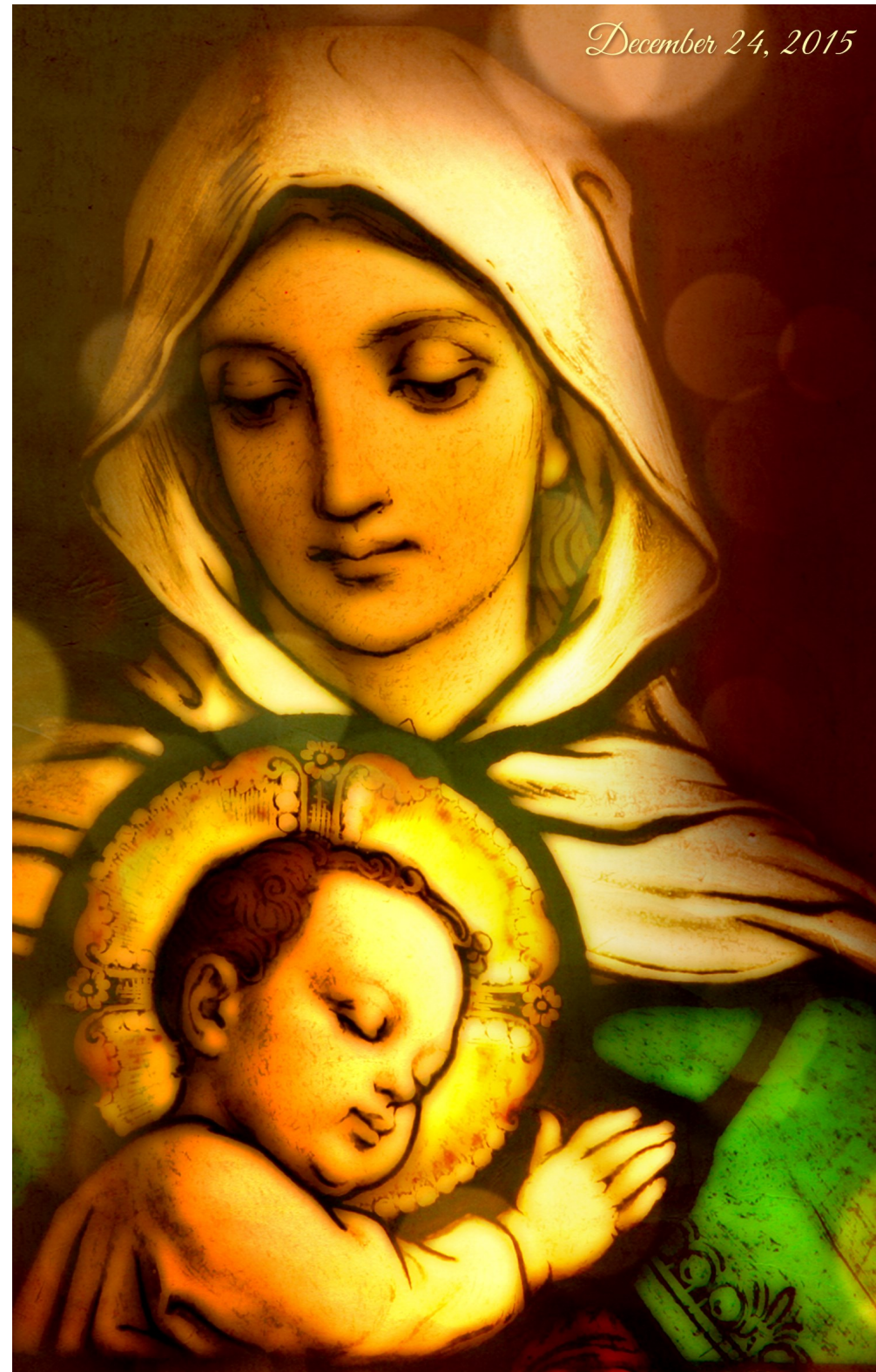

Your prayer requests are important to us and confidentiality is honored. You can make a prayer request on your Welcome Place Card or on-line at stlukecolumbus.com/prayer.

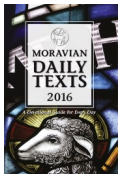
Assisted listening devices are available at the Welcome Center for use in the Traditional Sanctuary.
