 7. **Seven Steps To Break Free From Abuse.**
 - 1) Don't keep it a secret. Tell someone safe who can help.
 - 2) Name the abuse. Sexual. Physical. Emotional.
Forms of emotional abuse: aggravation, intimidation, denigration, humiliation, manipulation, domination, defamation, condemnation.
 - 3) Don't minimize or rationalize the abuse. Abuse is never right.
 - 4) Help abuse victims to find a safe place if necessary.
 - 5) Don't confront the abuser by yourself. Get help.
 - 6) Begin the healing process. Seek professional therapy.
 - 7) Let God settle the score. Do not take revenge.
