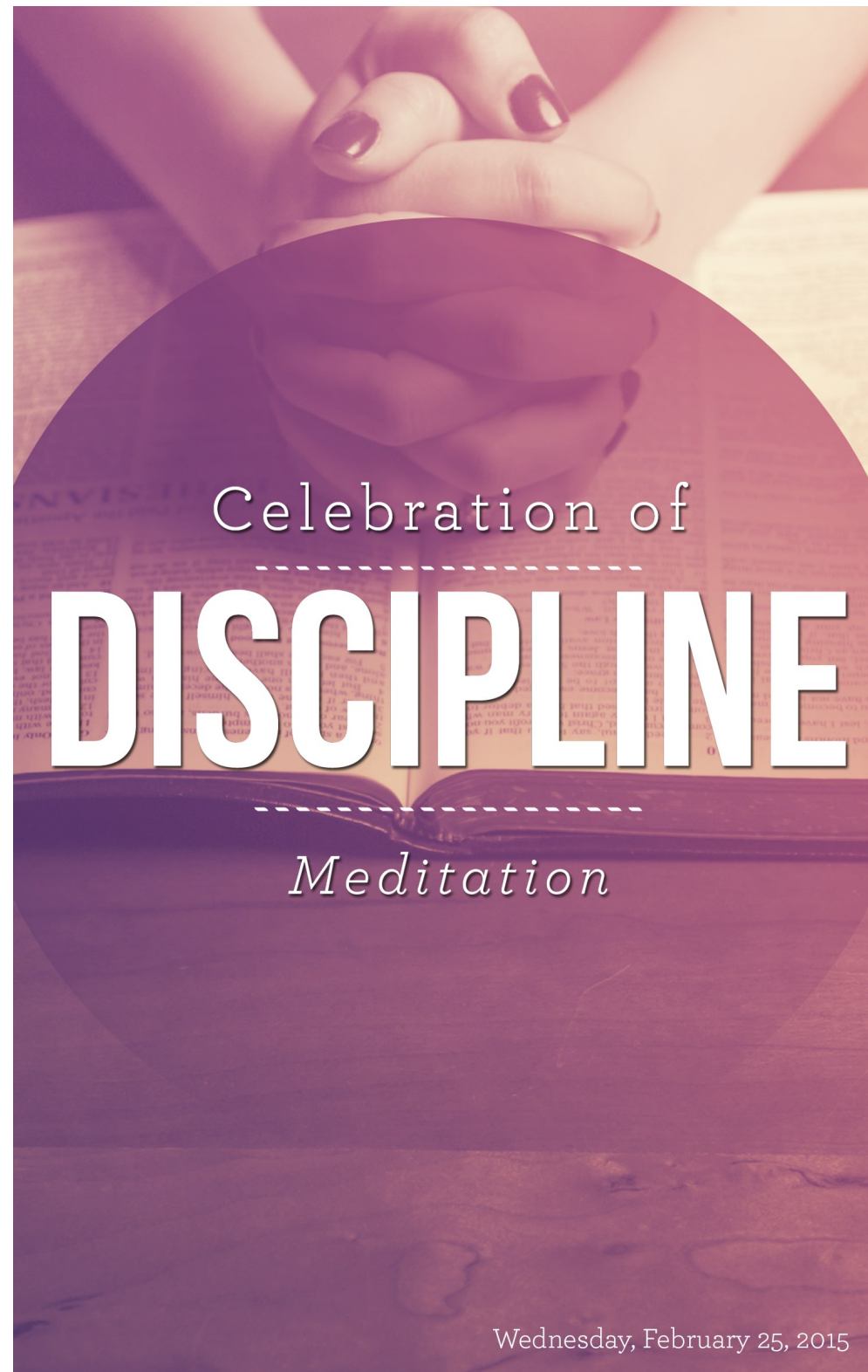

Confession & Forgiveness

Leader: Let us pray. Almighty God, we know our transgressions and our sin is ever before us. Against you, you alone, have we sinned, and done what is evil in your sight. Hide your face from our sins, and blot out all our rebellion against you. Create in us a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within us.

Congregation: Amen

L: By God's gracious work, our practice of the Spiritual Disciplines becomes the door through which God changes our lives and liberates us from our bondage to ingrained habits that violate God's values. When we practice the discipline of confession, we place ourselves in the good soil where we hear from the heart of God that our sins are forgiven and that the confession of our evil works is the first beginning of good works. Therefore, with contrite hearts, we humble ourselves before the Lord, and confess our sins.

↓ *Sit or kneel*

L: Most merciful God,

C: **I, confess to you that I am in bondage to sin and cannot free myself. I have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what I have done and by what I have left undone. I have not loved you with my whole heart; I have not loved my neighbors as myself. I confess before you, my God, that I am guilty of many sins. Especially I confess that ...** *(Silently confess to God any sins that particularly trouble you.)*

L: Father God, for the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ,

C: **Have mercy on me. Forgive me, renew me, and lead me, so that I may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.**

↑ L: Hear now, deep calling out to deep as God speaks from his heart into your heart. Through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, † God has forgiven all your sins. In the eyes of your heavenly Father you stand healed of all that was broken in your life. Now let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

C: **Amen.**
